

Cookies policy of CINETPERU S.A.C.

This website or platform, owned by CINETPERU S.A.C. (hereinafter CINETPERU), like most portals or websites, uses cookies to improve the user experience. Below, you will find information about what cookies are, what type of cookies this portal uses and how you can manage cookies in your browser. What are cookies?

Cookies are data storage and retrieval devices that are installed on the user's device in order to store information and retrieve the information stored while you browse our website. In general, these technologies can be used for many different purposes, such as, for example, recognising you as a user, obtaining information about your browsing habits, or personalising the way in which content is displayed. The specific uses we make of these technologies are detailed below.

What type of cookies does this website use?

This website uses the following types of cookies depending on their purpose:

Essential technical cookies and personalisation cookies: These cookies are necessary to manage browsing on the website or to keep the user connected. They also allow information to be remembered so that the user can access the service with certain characteristics that may differentiate their experience from that of other users (language of the website, number of search results, etc.).

Analytical cookies: These are cookies that allow us to monitor and analyse users through our website, with the aim of introducing improvements based on the analysis of the data on the use made by users of the website.

Cookies can be first-party or third-party cookies:

Own Cookies: These are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain managed by CINETPERU, and from which the service requested by the user is provided.

Third-party cookies: These are cookies that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by CINETPERU, but by

another entity that processes the data obtained through the cookies, such as, for example, Google Analytics cookies.

Finally, cookies can be session or persistent cookies:

Session cookies: These are designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page. They are usually used to store information that we are only interested in keeping for the provision of the service requested by the user on a single occasion, and then disappear when the user leaves our website.

Persistent cookies: These are cookies in which the data continues to be stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed for a period defined by the party responsible for the cookie, which can range from minutes to a maximum limit of two years.

How can you manage cookies?

Technical and personalisation cookies are installed on the user's device when accessing the website, as they are necessary for the website to function correctly. The user cannot deactivate this type of cookies.

CINETPERU offers the user the possibility of managing analytical cookies through the cookies banner at the top of our website. The installation of analytical cookies will only take place if the user expressly accepts their installation.

In this regard, in the cookies banner on our website you can select the "reject" button, in which case only the technical and personalisation cookies necessary for the operation of the website will be installed, or "accept", in which case the aforementioned analytical cookies will be installed in addition.

How can you configure the preferences in your browser?

You can allow, block or delete the cookies installed on your terminal by configuring the options of your internet browser. In the event that you block them, it is possible that certain services that require their use will not be available to you.
